Dear Parents and Families,

In line with San Diego Unified School District's response to COVID-19, City Heights Prep will be closing alongside all other schools from March 16th until April 6th (unless conditions call for an extension).

During this time, we will continue to provide meals and educational instruction to all of our students, but through new means. Some important things to note about the new meal distribution procedures are that:

- Meals will continue to be provided to all students, and will be distributed at designated schools throughout the district
- These grab-and-go meals will be available at drive-up/walk-in stations at the following locations:
 - Clark Middle (to act as a production kitchen and serving center)
 - Cherokee Point Elementary
 - Sherman Elementary
 - Zamorano Fine Arts Academy
 - Kearny High School
 - O'Farrell Charter
 - Farb Middle
 - Walker Elementary
- These eight sites have been strategically selected based on geographic location targeting high need areas – per the USDA.
- Children will need to be present to receive meals, and each child 18 years and younger can take one lunch and one breakfast for the next day. There will be no congregate feeding. All food will be consumed off site. Meal distribution times for all locations are 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.
